

### PACKING LIST FROM THE CROSSINGS CAMP:

- A fantastic attitude and a desire to grow in your faith
- Bible, pen, & notebook  
**Bibles are important as students will NOT have their phones while at camp. If you need a Bible, please let us know and we will gift one to your student.**
- Casual clothing for 4-5 days  
*Shorts that are at least fingertip length and pants are acceptable for all meetings, including worship*
- Beach towel for water day
- Plan on bringing 3 extra sets of clothing  
*These should be suitable for getting wet/dirty -no white*
- Sleepwear
- Closed toe shoes for recreation time
- Sturdy shorts for specific activities (i.e. zip line)
- Personal hygiene items  
*please don't forget deodorant 😊*
- Spending money for travel, snacks, t-shirts, and snack shack
- Watch  
*This is helpful because they won't have phones*
- pants and a lightweight jacket for the possibility of cool evenings
- Appropriate swimwear/cover-up
  - Guys: shirts must be worn to and from lake/pool
  - Girls: must be one pieces with shorts or swim shorts worn over them at all times
- Comfortable shoes for walking and being active
- Shoes for getting wet
- Bedding  
*Twin sheets, blanket or sleeping bag, & pillow*
- Towels for showering
- Toiletries  
*Soap, Shampoo, Deodorant, Toothbrush, etc.*
- Sunblock & Bug Spray

### **OPTIONAL:**

- Space themed attire
- Alarm clock if you have one
- Camera (phones will not be in use)

### ADDITIONAL THINGS TO PACK FROM FBC LEADERS:

- Medication  
*Students will be responsible for their own medications. If you, the parent, feel they need additional supervision, you must contact us prior to camp.*
- At least \$50 for meals on travel days, and additional funds for souvenirs, snacks etc.

- Snacks for fun
- Refillable water bottle

### THINGS NOT TO BRING (FROM THE CROSSINGS)

- Spaghetti strap tops, halter tops, and tube tops.  
Tank tops that are at least three fingers wide can be worn during the day, but not to evening worship.
- Tight clothing
- "Short" shorts or skirts (ex. Nike pros, etc. Stand with your arms by your side. If your fingertips are touching skin, your shorts should be longer for camp.)
- Bikinis or any two piece bathing
- Speedos
- Tobacco, drugs, alcohol or weapons
- Fireworks
- Water balloons
- Clothing with questionable sayings, slogans, etc.
- Clothing that promotes alcohol, cigarettes or any other inappropriate items

### ADDITIONAL THINGS NOT TO BRING (FROM FBC)

- Stuff for pranks
